Spring Hope area residents only. A group of 13 area churches work together and give what they can. Must be eligible for food stamps to receive services. Bring eligibility form from Nash County DSS. Individuals can come in 4 times per year to get 2 outfits per season for each adult and 1 pair of shoes per year. Children

receive items as well. Food bags are given out on Fridays. Individuals can pick them up once per month. It is enough food to last a couple of days. It's meant to supplement food stamps. They try to assist with utilities once per year. They also have a resale store (clothing & household items).

Filling in the gaps. Services Nash & Edgecombe counties. Case by case basis. This program assists with rent and utilities once every 12 months. The recipient must have an income. Assistance is only provided due to an unforeseen circumstance and the individual can't pay that particular month, but usually they pay their own bills. Local churches give money to Nash and Edgecombe county DSS for this program. Individuals may call any of the churches involved and the church will send a referral to DSS.
