Last year with United Way Campaign Funding, we served:

- **23,504** children and families impacted through our Education Programs
- **23,224** folks receiving support for ensuring basic needs are met-food, shelter, financial challenges
- **6,041** folks impacted through health programs that encourage healthy life styles, access to medicines, etc.

- OVERHEAD is 20.5 % = right at \$.80 cents of each dollar goes directly into our local community to help our citizens.

Tornado Recovery:

- Raised \$550,000 +
- Included in the \$550,000 were funds from Pfizer so we could help their employees who had damaged vehicles.
- Assisted 250 local citizens clean up, rebuild, and get into new homes.
- Recognized by the state for our best practices in our local response; especially since this tornado damage did not reach the financial levels to be declared a federal disaster.
- Incredible that we helped every person who reached out to us for assistance.
- Our goal at United Way is to maintain a disaster fund so that we can be ready for the next situation that occurs in our local community.

NC 211:

- Service our United Way has had available since 2008
- Thousands use this service each year, especially used during the pandemic, and also used during natural disasters like our hurricanes
- Free Informational and Referral line and website where community members can access community resources and programs 24/7/365 in multiple languages.
- In 2025 alone, the NC 211 service assisted **4,968** of our local citizens
