
EMERGENCY FOOD & SHELTER PROGRAM

Our United Way continues to serve as the administrator for the National Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP). The EFSP is a Federal program administered by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency. Funding is based on unemployment and poverty rates in our community and helps provide essential emergency food and shelter, and Nash & Edgecombe counties were awarded \$259,254 for both Phases 36, Phase 37 & Phase CARES. The EFSP Advisory Board, with Board Chair, Warren Stephenson, oversaw the distribution of these funds to community Local Recipient Agencies that include: A Touch of the Father's Love, Christian Fellowship Homes, Mercer Foundation, Michael's Angels Girls Club, My Sister's House, N.E.E.D., Ripple Effects, St. Andrew's Church, Tarboro Community Outreach, The REACH Center, The Salvation Army, Truth Foundational Ministries and United Community Ministries.



DISASTER RECOVERY

We have remained a lead agency in Long-Term hurricane recovery serving with the Twin Counties Disaster Recovery Group. As the fiscal agent for this group, over a three-year span, we have helped secure approximately \$235,000 in funds and a signficant supply of other donations to assist local citizens as they moved back into permanent housing after loss and displacement as a result of a natural disaster.



COVID-19

Our United Way responded efficiently and quickly as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. We mobilized \$162,810 in funds to help address challenges for approximately 18,000 children, families and individuals impacted by COVID-19. Through an efficient and accountable grants process, United Way worked with nonprofit partners to address urgent needs in feeding, housing, individual/ family stability, childcare, and youth, senior & special populations' support, while encouraging innovative programming and community partnerships.
